**Martin Vye is fighting for a better deal for our youth, for our roads and pavements to be fixed and for better day care centres for the vulnerable.**

### A better deal for the youth of Canterbury

The Conservative run Kent County Council spends less on it's young people than almost any other council. However, Lib Dem Kent County Councillor, Martin believes in high quality youth clubs and facilities for young people. Each year Martin allocates several thousand pounds from his councillor grant money to getting youth workers for the Thanington and London Road Estate.

### Safer roads

Roads and pavements in our city are a disgrace damaging cars and tripping up elderly people. As an experienced councillor Martin has been fighting hard for proper repair and maintenance. At Martin's request, Kent County Council mapped all the road flooding "hot spots" and he is now pressing them to solve the problem by investing properly in new road drains.

Martin continues to make road safety one of his priorities. He has worked with other councillors and parish councillors to get speed controls on the Ashford Road.

He is campaigning for speed controls on Whitstable Road and Hollow Lane, 20mph limits in residential areas, more pedestrian crossings on busy main roads and investment in road drainage to stop flooding.

### Better education

Martin's drive for many years has been to ensure that children and young people get the best possible education. He is a longstanding governor of two primary schools. Each year he

helps parents with appeals for school places and free transport.

He has set up an International Youth Council to help older young children meet and debate with young people in other countries.

### Better day care centres

The County Council is responsible for looking after the welfare of vulnerable people. The day centre for people with learning disabilities in Cow Lane was threatened with removal. Martin has been helping users, parents and carers to fight for a new centre that will meet with their needs. He believes elderly people and people with disabilities should be able to stay in their own homes and will help them obtain adaptations and equipment to help them do that.

## Not good enough!

**At the current rate of repair it would take Conservative Run Kent County Council 300 years to bring roads and pavements up to proper repair.**

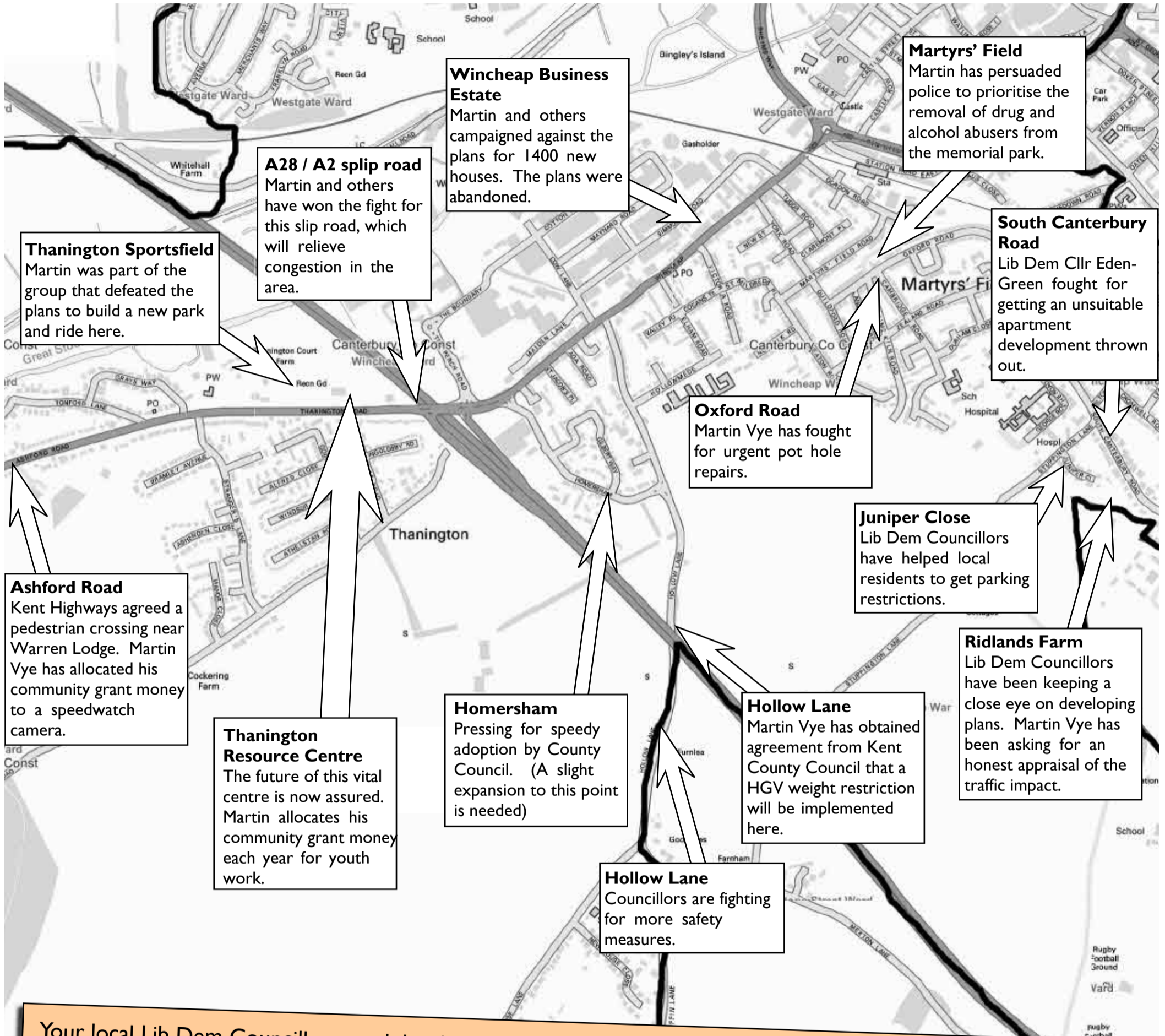
