			As you will be aware there have been several accidents at this junction with vehicles inadvertently turning right from the A228 M20 bound, across the oncoming traffic and into Castle Way. While I am not aware of the details of the recent accident which took place at this junction some 3 weeks ago, it is of concern that the street signage which was completely wrecked in this accident which also included the No Entry sign have still not been removed and replaced. For motorists therefore the only obvious signage that this is a no entry is by road markings which are not always obviously visible. While I would trust that a review of the dangers of the junction at this location is still being reviewed can you please advice the Parish Council who is responsible for the replacement of these damaged signs?
